OVERVIEW

The Native American Center for Health Professions (NACHP) within the UW School of Medicine and Public Health (UWSMPH) is offering a rotation stipend for visiting medical students.

- 2 or 4 week rotation options.
- Stipend amounts: 2-week (\$2,500), 4-week (\$5,000).
 - Stipends are divided into two installments and disbursed at the beginning and conclusion of the rotation.
- Stipend is provided to assist with housing and travel expenses.
- A pre-rotation orientation with NACHP staff is provided.
- This opportunity is for medical students who are enrolled with a federally recognized tribe and/or have demonstrated a strong commitment to American Indian/Alaska Native communities.
